



## Streets of Lancaster Grand Prix 2010 Race Rules

Welcome to the Streets of Lancaster Grand Prix sponsored by Lancaster Honda, the City of Lancaster and hosted by Tri-C Karters. The Grand Prix is the centerpiece of a celebration weekend including a street festival, live music, classic car show and charity racing events. We hope that this event will be a unique, exciting and memorable experience for you, your family and crew. The Grand Prix will be run under IKF general competition regulations. Specific technical rules will apply as noted on the entry form: Rotax classes will use RMAX rules; TAG and shifter classes will use SKUSA rules; and all other classes will use IKF tech rules.

**Directions to the track:** From I-14, exit at Avenue I; go east; turn right on Sierra Highway. The pit area entrance is on Sierra Highway, a few blocks south of Avenue I.

**Pit Parking:** The pits will be open for trailer parking and setup from noon until 7:00 on Thursday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, and will reopen for parking at 6:30 AM on Friday. All tow vehicles must be parked outside the pits in pre-designated parking areas. Pit parking is on a first come, first served basis, however Tri-C will try to accommodate any special needs, tents, or team pits. Contact Taylor Jocelyn at (949)678-3289 to discuss any special needs. A forklift with a hitch will be available to help maneuver trailers safely into spots. We expect the pit area to be very crowded. If you can share pit space with another competitor it would be very appreciated. The overflow pit area will be at the North end of the track directly on Sierra Highway. Racers in the Kid Kart and Vintage classes should refer to the Tri-C Karters web site, [www.tri-ckarters.com](http://www.tri-ckarters.com) after October 1st for special parking instructions.

**Pre-entry check-in:** Thursday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, the Grand Prix registration will be open from 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. at the Panache Salon, 747 W. Lancaster Blvd. We encourage drivers to sign in, pick up their entry packets and get their swag bags as soon as possible. Additional fuel and oil vouchers can also be purchased at all registration times.

Registration will open in the pit area at 7:00AM on Friday and Saturday.

Unregistered drivers may enter the event at registration on Thursday, Friday or Saturday.

**Friday Evening Drivers' Reception:** The City of Lancaster is hosting a competitors reception at the Roshambo Lounge, 706 W. Lancaster Blvd. from 6:00PM to 8:00PM. Tickets for this event are in each driver's swag bag.

**Fuel:** All pre-registered entries will have one voucher, in their entry packet, for a 5 gallon can of VP racing fuel and either 32 ounces of Burris Hi-Rev Castor oil or 1 liter of Motul oil. All unregistered competitors will be required to purchase race fuel and oil at the event. Additional vouchers may be purchased at registration for \$80.00.

Fuel and oil will be distributed as follows:

Competitors will receive their oil at registration. Fuel can be picked up Friday and Saturday from 7AM until noon at the fuel truck in the fenced area adjoining the grid.

**Fuel for exhibition classes:**

Kid Karts must use MS98 with Burris Hi-Rev Castor. Race fuel will be supplied at no cost, but racers must supply their own practice fuel.

Vintage Kart racers must supply their own fuel and oil.

**Tires:** Spec tires are required as follows:

Participants in the Rotax classes must race using any new or used tires originally purchased from, and stamped by, Full Throttle Karting. You may purchase tires in advance and take delivery at the race. Contact FTK at (714)289-0432 to place your order.

ProKart Challenge will be set up at the track to sell/distribute MG-FZ race tires for the Shifter and TAG classes. Participants in these classes must purchase PKC **SLGP** stamped race tires for the event. In addition, ProKart Challenge has MG-FZ tires available to order for practice.

**ProKart Challenge has a special offer for all participants: order your stamped race tires (or practice tires) by October 4<sup>th</sup> online and receive free shipping to your designated location. You can also order your practice/race tires for Event Delivery. There will not be an on-site vendor for Bridgestone tires. Racers will be responsible for bringing their own practice and race tires, or arranging for event delivery from their local kart shop in advance.

**The same set of tires must be used for Qualifying, Pre-main, and Main events for all classes.**

<p><b>Please take all used tires home with you at the close of the event. Tires cannot be put in trash receptacles or left at the event site.</b></p>

**Pretech:** There is a pre-tech self-certification form in your race entry packet. Please examine your kart for the safety items on the checklist. Your kart is required to have all applicable safety items and/or conditions on the checklist. By marking and signing the certification form you are stating your kart is legal for racing. Turn in the self-certification form at the scales to receive your tech sticker. You must have the tech sticker on your kart before driving on the track. If during a post-tech inspection your kart is missing a safety item on the checklist, you will be disqualified for that race. If you have questions or require assistance, please see the tech director.

**Participants in Rotax classes must also have their karts and engines inspected, and seal numbers recorded, by the tech director. This declaration process needs to be completed on Friday between the hours of 12:00PM and 5:00PM.**

**Transponders:** We are using AMB electronic scoring. If you do not own an AMB transponder, you may rent one at registration. Rental transponders may be picked up at registration on Friday afternoon if you are practicing, or early Saturday morning. Rental transponders must be returned immediately after your main event on Sunday. If you leave early, for any reason, please turn in your transponder to registration before exiting the pits. Drivers will be responsible for loss or damage to rental transponders. Transponders must be

mounted according to the applicable tech rules. If you have questions or need assistance mounting your transponder, please see tech personnel.

**Announcements:** Due to the difficulty in operating a sound system on a temporary track, Tri-C Karters will be supplementing the P.A. system with an FM broadcast. Tune your radio to the designated station to hear the race announcer. The station will be announced and posted in the pits on Friday morning.

**Qualifying:** The qualifying order will be determined by the recorded times from the final practice session on Friday. All qualifying sessions will be timed. There will **not** be a "Hot Pit." If you exit the track during your qualifying session, your session is over. Each entrant may have no more than one mechanic on the grid. Follow the directions of the grid steward when entering and exiting the grid. At the conclusion of each qualifying session, competitors must weigh and have their karts inspected by tech officials. Tires and engines will be marked and may not be changed after qualifying without the consent of tech officials. **At all times during the event, no one will be allowed on the grid without an insurance wristband and a crew or driver hard card (these cards will be issued at registration).**

**Fire Safety:** Per IKF rule 105.1.4.1 It is mandatory that each entry in the event have a minimum of one operable 1 ½-pound dry powder fire extinguisher (rated for use on A, B & C type fires) accessible in their pit and on the starting grid at the start of each race and in the hot pit area. Carbon Dioxide type fire extinguishers are not an acceptable substitute for the dry powder type. There is no smoking allowed in the pit area or on the grid. The City of Lancaster fire marshal will be inspecting the pit and grid areas for fire safety compliance.

**Conduct:** All competitors, their families, friends and pit crews are guests of the City of Lancaster and are representatives of Tri-C Karters, Gatorz, ProKart Challenge and the sport of karting. The Streets of Lancaster Grand Prix and its affiliated events are all family oriented. Competitors must conduct themselves in a professional manner throughout the event. Unsportsmanlike conduct and/or profanity within the event area (i.e. pits, grid, tech...) will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification and/or expulsion from the event. Consumption of alcohol in the pit areas is strictly prohibited during competition. Competitors are responsible for the conduct of their respective guests and pit crews.

At designated times, spectators will be allowed access to the pits. Please welcome these spectators and courteously answer their questions. They may be a future racer or sponsor.

At the conclusion of the event, leave your pit area as clean as you found it. Do not leave any used tires or fuel containers behind. Show respect for city property at all times.

**Protests:** Any protests must be filed within 30 minutes after the track session being questioned. Protest forms are available at registration.

**Quiet hours:** No engines may be started up before 8:00AM or after 6:00PM. Loud music and talking in the pits or camping areas is prohibited from 10:00PM until 7:00AM.
